DIPLOMA FOR WORLD WAR II AND KOREAN CONFLICT VETERANS
Board of Education Policy IL-C

In accordance with Section 3313.614 and 3313.616 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Northwest Local School District may grant a high school diploma to a veteran who served in any branch of the armed forces of the United States during World War II or the Korean Conflict. The local application procedures for the diploma will fulfill all requirements of the law. If a veteran who would otherwise qualify for a diploma under this section is deceased, the Board of Education may award such diploma to the veteran posthumously and may present that diploma to a living relative of the veteran.

DIPLOMA FOR WORLD WAR II AND KOREAN CONFLICT VETERANS

In appreciation for service to the United States of America, the Northwest Local School District will offer high school diplomas to World War II and Korean Conflict veterans. To receive the diploma the candidate must meet the following requirements:

- A. The veteran is an Ohio resident or was previously enrolled in any high school in this state.
- B. The veteran left a public or nonpublic school located in any state prior to graduation in order to serve in the armed forces of the United States.
- C. The veteran left a public or nonpublic school located in any state prior to graduation due to family circumstances and subsequently entered the armed forces of the United States.
- D. The veteran received an honorable discharge from the armed forces of the United States.
- E. The veteran has not been granted a high school diploma or a diploma of adult education.
- F. The veteran must verify his/her service record to the Hamilton County Veterans Service Commission with an original copy of the DD214 discharge document or other proof of service. The Hamilton County Veterans Service Commission is located at 230 E. Ninth Street, Room 1100, First Floor, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202. Call the Hamilton County Veterans Service Commission (513-946-3305) or the Northwest Administrative Office (513-923-1000) to obtain a copy of the certification form.

G. The veteran's certification is submitted to the Northwest Administrative Office along with an application for a diploma.

The Northwest Board of Education will award diplomas to World War II and Korean Conflict veterans at Board of Education meetings.
